New Year To Serve One Another

Over the last several months some of us experienced misfortunes, discouragements, offended, and experience difficult situation on family or in the ministry. But those things are little things compares to the victories that's Gods provides in each in everyone.

Apostle Paul says PRESS ON forget those things REACHING FORWARD for new and big things in store ahead.

Now is another year 2008 has began, do you still have the Desire, Passion, Zeal to serve one another? How do we do it?

Consider what apostle Peter exhorts in 1 Pet. 4:8-11 in this text Peter exhorts all believers to fervent love: a love that expresses itself in hospitality and in gift giving to one another.

“How Can WE Serve One Another”

1. Have an Attitude Of Love.— Peter opens with “above all...” When you read these words your ears ought to perk up. You are about to hear something of great importance. According to Peter what follows is of primary significance to the Christian life. This greatly important thing is love; fervent love for each other. It is our primary duty as a believers to love God and love of neighbor.
2. By Exercise your Gift.— verse 10 says each

one has received a gift, minister it to one another. Its not how big the ministry your holding or how important you are in the ministry. But rather do we use the gift that God deposits on you. Peter says to those whose have the gifts of teaching or of serving. You are to use your gifts with the ability that God Himself provides. That means that we cannot say “I can’t” when you are ministering. The ability and resources don’t come from you. They come from Almighty God.

3. In the Spirit Of Grace.— Peter show where the power and ability to serve and love comes from God. God is not requiring us to love your neighbor out of your own resources and strength. Rather, the love which you must show, including the willingness to let people live with you or eat at your table, is the outflow of the grace and gifts that you have already received.

As we Doing These in Serving One Another God May Be Glorified Through Jesus Christ. And just as the grace to love and to use your gifts in service to your neighbor are the gifts and enabling of God, so too the praise and glory for your service and love must flow back to God alone. He must receive the glory in all things because to Him belongs all the glory and dominion from ages to ages.
Amen.
