What is prayer? Prayer is asking God for things or something. The main thing about prayer is offering up the desires unto God. In Prov. 15:8b says “the prayer of the upright is His delight.” If prayer is asking God for things and He is delighted in our prayers then God loves to be

asked for things. Isaiah tells us that God is eager to hear our prayers and respond. God appoint people to give Him no rest, and never be silent. Remind Him by praises, His goodness and His mercy.

David was in great distress and danger because Saul is persecuting him. And he pleaded God, asking to rescue him in Saul's hand. He

prayed always for God's deliverance. And God answered him because of his faithfulness and righteousness.

In this passage (Ps 143:1-12) we can see and feel the intensity of David's prayer. If we follow this kind of prayer that David does, we can see that difficulties can be turn into blessings;

A. Why we should pray?

1. God is faithful..(v.1) Ps. 33:4-97:10-145:13b
2. God is righteous..(v.1) Ps.37:25-119:137-145:17
3. God is holy..(2)..Ps.16:10-77:13
4. We are overwhelmed..(v.4) Ps.38:4-65:3
5. We remember God's power..(v.5) remember what God has done for us in the past (psalms 77:5-11)
