The word rapture comes from Latin words rapio which means "a snatching away." It is the time when the Lord comes in the cloud of glory, bodily (Acts.1:11) to takeout of this world also bodily, all those who died in

Christ and those who are still living as believers in the Savior. (1 Thes.4:16-18) The Apostles Paul clearly states in 1 Cor.15:49-50 that we will be changed into a wonderful, eternal and immortal body.

What would be our body like? Our Lord is the best example for this wonderful event.

- A. After His resurrection he could appear and disappear at will...Lk.24:31- John 20:19
- B. He could move through solid walls..John 20;19,26
- C. He could be seen and felt...Matt.28:9- Lk.24:36-42
- D. He could eat food, though not necessary...Lk.24:41-43
- E. He could be recognized though glorified...Lk.24;30-31
- F. Our resurrected bodies will no longer experience pain, sicknesses, death, mourning, sorrow pain aging... (Rev.21:4)

Illustration of rapture or the snatching away in the Old and New Testament:

- A. Enoch walked with God and God took him..Gen.5:21-24-Heb.11:5

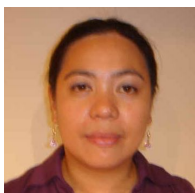
- B. Elisha watched as Elijah was taken to heaven...2 Kings 2:1-12
- C. The words of Isaiah in Isa.26:19-20 clearly define the snatching away of believers. They will be protected in a room, that God has prepared for His saints, until His wrath pass by.
- D. One of the Apostles in the New testament named Philip while witnessing to an Ethiopian official, after baptizing him, the Spirit of the Lord suddenly took Philip away, and the eunuch did not see him again, but went on his way and appeared at Azotus.(Acts.8:26-40)
- E. The Lord was taken up (rapture) to heaven after He had spoken to the disciples ..Mark 16:19 Additional passage for reading the rapture verses (snatching away) 1 Cor.15:50-54- 1Thes.4:13-18.
- F. The male child was snatched up (rapture) to God and to his throne...Rev.12:5.It describes the ascension of Christ to heaven.
- G. In Lk.24:49-53...here while He was blessing them He parted from them and was carried up into heaven(v.51) read also Acts 1:6-11
- H. The two witnesses in Rev.11:11-12. They went up into heaven in the clouds.

We have all the time to prepare ourselves to this wonderful event that will be coming to the world...but this is for those who believe and obey only in the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. Our only chance is to accept Him in our hearts as Lord and Savior of our lives. Accept and obey the word of God because the time is very short!!!

YOUR WORD as a BELIEVER of Christ! It is the ultimate reality that underlies all outward manifestations and change. It is the right ATTITUDE that we must see through Believers.
YES and NO is a very simple word, but I can say, it is a word that sometimes very hard to do.
-Sometimes it's so easy to say Yes or promise to a person without thinking, if we can do what we say

and what we promise. Sometimes it's so easy to say No to a person; even we can do what that person is pleading. Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking lies Psalm 34:13. David said that a person who fears the Lord doesn't lie, turns from evil, does well, and promotes peace. Reverence is much more than sitting quietly in church. It includes obeying God in the way we speak and the way we treat others.

WHY?

You will be CONDEMN James 5:12 Above all, my brothers, do not swear-not by heaven or by earth or by anything else. Let your "Yes" be yes, and your "No," no, or you will be condemned. – A person with a reputation for exaggeration or lying often can't get anyone to believe him on his word alone. Christians should never become like that. Always be honest so that others will believe your simple yes or no. By avoiding lies, half-truths, and omissions of the truth, you will become known as a trustworthy person.

RESULT

" So that you may be proved right when you speak and prevail when you judge" Romans 3:4 I have learned from this passage.
