Conscription also known as “The Draft” the “Call-Up” is a general term for involuntary labor demanded by an established authority. It is most often used in the specific sense of government poli-

cies that require citizens to serve in the armed forces. This term refers only to the mandatory service.

Compulsory service of young men of a given age (18-27 or 20-41 it varies on the country) for a set of period of time, commonly one to two years. Countries like China, South Korea, Ukraine Taiwan and Egypt are some of the countries undergoing this system. Also in Israel, it has a mandatory military service for both Jewish men and women not married by the conscription age; some ethnic and religious group are exempt. Typically, men serve for 36 months, women for 21 months.

During the world war in Japan, compulsory service called “Shoushiu Reija” in Japanese, chosen men were sent a red paper letter called “Akagami” for them to report at once in the military service in preparation for them to forcibly fight in the war for their country.

As believers of our Lord Jesus Christ. We were called for service thru voluntary submission and surrender of our lives in Him. Once we accept Him we were given the “akagami” letter sealed by the blood of Jesus to fight for a Spi-

5. Pamumuno - kaloob ng Diyos na gagabay at mamahala sa iba't-ibang mga Gawain ng iglesia, para sa espirituwal na kabutihan ng lahat. (1 Timothy 3:1-7)
6. Pagkawang-gawa - kaloob ng Diyos para tumulong at umaliw sa mga may pangagailangan o may pagdurusa. (Efeso:2:4)
